

Latah County “Citizen” Alert System

The Latah County Sheriff’s Office, in coordination with the Latah County Disaster Services Department, is excited to announce a new alert system that will send emergency notifications right to your phone.

This alert system, powered through Everbridge, has been put in place to notify you of emergency situations in your area. Examples of this include but are not limited to, natural or man-made disasters, hazardous material incidents, missing persons, law enforcement activity impacting the public, emergency evacuation notices and more.

By signing up for these emergency alerts, you will receive notifications for the address you registered and/or your current location (if you download the Everbridge mobile app).

The Everbridge system allows for multiple forms of communication to be used for notification such as text messages, phone calls, emails, mobile app notifications and more. After you confirm the receipt of the notification, the system will stop sending further notifications to your other registered forms of communication. If you don’t confirm the receipt of the notification, the system will continue to reach you at your other registered contact methods.

During emergency situations, it is important to stay connected and have multiple sources of information. This system is only one of those methods. The Latah County team suggests you also tune into news broadcasts, social media posts from trusted sources, weather reports and more to stay safe.

Everbridge is a great tool to be able to help keep our community informed and safe.
